

CIRCULAR TAKE-BACK STATEMENT FOR PRETTY PLASTIC TILES

Pretty Plastic is committed to a circular economy where waste is eliminated and raw materials are endlessly reused. Our tiles are composed of 100% recycled PVC, processed into a granulate compound with 3% fire-retardant material (ATH) and colour pigment (depending on colour intensity, up to a maximum of 2%). These additions have no effect on the recyclability of the material, making it suitable for upcycling.

Used in various national and international projects, Pretty Plastic tiles are part of a closed-loop system - and we need your help to keep it that way!

RETURNING TILES

Whether you are returning unused tiles (in case of surplus or visible defects) or tiles at the end of their lifecycle, Pretty Plastic offers a structured return process:

- **EASY DISASSEMBLY:** Our tiles are designed for simple disassembly. See the Installation Manual for further details.
- **IDENTIFICATION AND RETURN PROCESS:** Instructions for returning tiles are available on our website, product sheets, and the tiles themselves. Each tile is imprinted with “return to prettyplastic.nl,” ensuring that all tiles can be identified and returned to our facility for reuse and upcycling into new Pretty Plastic tiles - keeping the material in a closed-loop system and preventing waste.

Pretty Plastic is committed to reusing and upcycling returned tiles, enabling the material to be reclaimed and repurposed rather than discarded. This approach helps to conserve resources, reduce waste, and minimise the environmental impact of our products.

REUSING TILES

By returning your tiles to Pretty Plastic, you are closing the loop on our product's lifecycle. The returned materials are continuously reused rather than discarded, incinerated, or sent to landfills. Depending on the condition of the returned tiles, they can be reused in various ways:

- **UNUSED TILES (SURPLUS OR UNDAMAGED RETURNS):** When tiles are inspected and found to be undamaged and defect-free, they can be directly reused in new projects. These are added back into Pretty Plastic's available inventory.
- **USED TILES (END-OF-LIFE RETURNS):** Tiles that are not suitable for direct reuse are shredded and returned to production as raw material. This enables upcycling without loss of material quality, supporting cradle-to-cradle manufacturing.

By accepting returns, Pretty Plastic contributes to conserving natural resources and reducing waste.

UPCYCLING TILES

Returned tiles (along with pre-consumer recyclate) are collected and stored at our production facility. The materials are then shredded and reused as raw material for new tiles. Thanks to the durability of recycled PVC, returned materials can be reused up to eight times without compromising quality - giving our tiles an estimated potential material lifespan of over 560 years.

ANNEX A: RETURN INSTRUCTIONS

HOW TO RETURN PRETTY PLASTIC TILES:

1. Prepare and disassemble

Tiles can be easily disassembled using standard tools. Refer to the Installation Manual for removal guidance.

2. Identify tiles

Every tile includes the imprint “return to prettyplastic.nl” which ensures material traceability.

3. Register your return

Please contact Pretty Plastic in advance to coordinate the return and confirm quantities, condition, and delivery location.

4. Select suitable return location

Small quantities: Amsterdam Headquarters
Large quantities: Production Facility in Uden

5. Follow packaging requirements

Tiles must be securely palletised or, for offcuts, returned in big bags.
(Packaging and transport conditions: see Annex C)

ANNEX C: RETURN CONDITIONS AND TRANSPORT COSTS

1. Scope of return guarantee

A maximum of 10 per cent of ordered, complete tiles may be credited. Only undamaged, standard products in original condition qualify.

2. Packaging requirements

All tiles must be bundled and securely placed on pallets. Returns not meeting packaging standards cannot be accepted.

3. Offcuts, half tiles, and residual waste

Offcuts and partial tiles are only accepted for upcycling when returned in big bags with a minimum total weight of 250 kg per shipment. These materials are not eligible for credit, but are accepted for upcycling.

4. Transport costs

The customer shall bear all transport costs for returning tiles or residual waste. Pretty Plastic does not reimburse transport costs unless otherwise agreed in writing.

5. Inspection and credit issuance

Credits are only issued after inspection and validation that tiles comply with quality and return standards.
